It is estimated that 38% of Canadian PA serve in primary care settings, 13% in internal medicine, 18% in surgical practice, and 19% in emergency medicine. American certified Physician Assistants may work in Canada. They do not need to complete a PA school in Canada to practice.

Where PAs and Physician Associates Can Work ...
Physician assistants may practice in primary care or medical specialties, including emergency medicine, surgery, cardiology, etc. Extensive clinical training precedes obtaining a certification to practice as a physician assistant. Physician assistant education is similar to physician training but shorter in duration.
